Short answers

Present simple

Do I/you/we/they/the students like chocolate?

Yes, I/you/we/they do.

No, I/you/we/they don't.

Does he/she/it/the class like chocolate?

Yes, he/she/it does.

No, he/she/it doesn't.

Present continuous

Am I working hard?

Yes, you are.

No, you aren't.

Are you working hard?

Yes, I am.

No, I'm not.

Is he/she/it/the class working hard?

Yes, he/she/it is.

No, he/she/it isn't.

Are we/they/the students working hard?

Yes, you/they are.

No, you/they aren't.

Past simple

Did I/you/he/she/it/we/they/the students/the class work hard?

Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they did.

No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they didn't.

Present perfect

Have I/you/we/they/the students eaten the chocolate?

Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they have.

No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they haven't.

Has he/she/it/the class eaten the chocolate?

Yes, he/she/it has.

No, he/she/it hasn't.

Present perfect

*Have I/you/we/they/the students **eaten** the chocolate?*

*Yes, I/you/he/she/it/we/they **have**.*

*No, I/you/he/she/it/we/they **haven't**.*

*Has he/she/it/the class **eaten** the chocolate?*

*Yes, he/she/it **has**.*

*No, he/she/it **hasn't**.*
